This is very different than someone deciding to go into professional ministry and being given the seal of approval, that is, ordained, by human beings to do that work. It is important to understand that someone can be ordained by human beings to do something and not be anointed by God to do that same thing. It is also possible that someone can be anointed by God to do something and not have the approval or blessing of human beings to do that.
